What Is POLYWOOD Made From?

Genuine POLYWOOD lumber is made from recycled and reusable high-density polyethylene (HDPE) plastic. HDPE is safe, durable, weather-resistant, and easy to clean—the perfect outdoor furniture material.

The vibrant color you see on the lumber's surface is not a veneer—it runs all the way through the material. Before transforming HDPE into lumber, we blend UV inhibitors, pigments, and other protective compounds with the plastic. Not only does this fully saturate the lumber with rich hues, but it also ensures long-lasting color that stays bright and vibrant year after year.

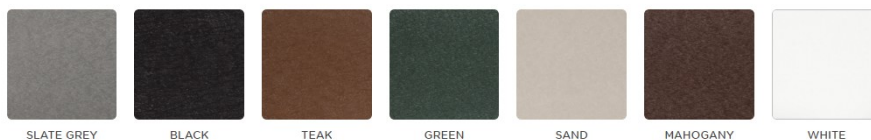


Vintage Finish

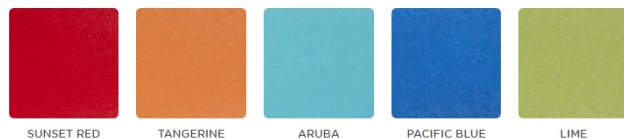
Inspired by wire-brush textures, our Vintage Finish evokes the richness and character of matte-painted wood but doesn't require refinishing after exposure to the elements.

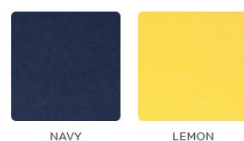

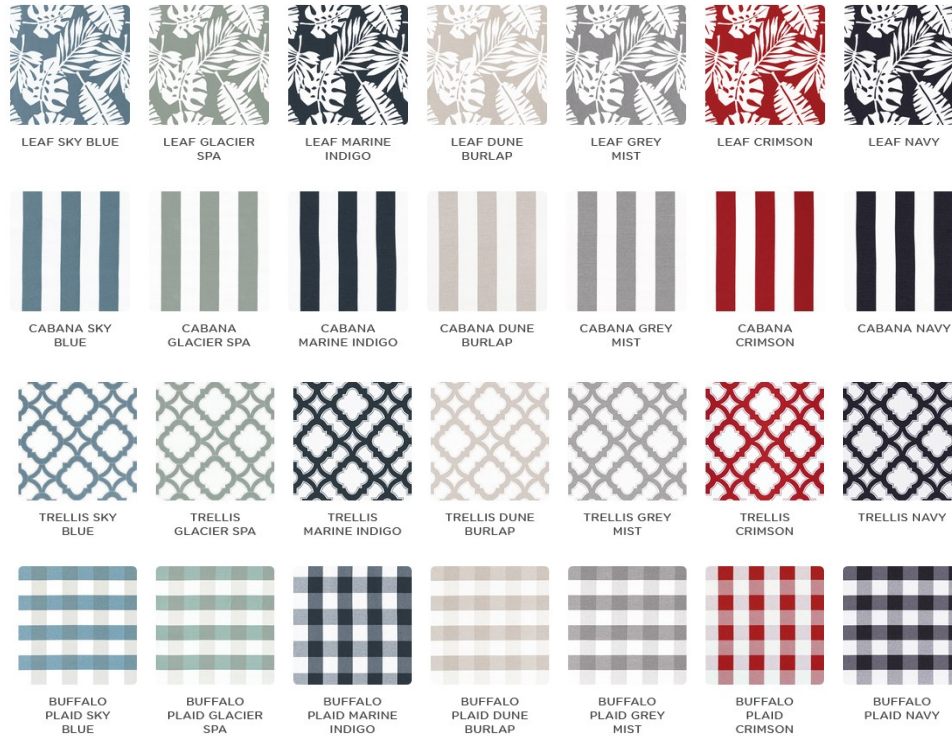
Performance Fabrics / Slings / Wickers

POLYWOOD Lumber FAQs

How much of the POLYWOOD plastic lumber is recycled?

99% of all production scraps, sending them back to our recycling plant to be remade into new lumber.

What is HDPE?

High-density polyethylene is a highly durable and reusable plastic used in a variety of everyday items, from laundry detergent bottles to decking.

Does POLYWOOD material fade?

Polywood lumber contains UV-inhibiting pigment systems that keep our colors vibrant and fade-resistant for years to come.

Can POLYWOOD material be sanded?

Polywood lumber should not be sanded as it will scratch the material's surface and void the warranty.

Does POLYWOOD material contain wood or natural fibers?

Polywood lumber only contains HDPE plastic, UV inhibitors, pigments, and other protective compounds.

Does the color of POLYWOOD lumber run all the way through the material?

Yes, light-stable pigments are mixed with UV inhibitors, and other protectants with the HDPE plastic before turning it into lumber, so the color you see on the surface is thoroughly blended throughout the material.

Can I paint my POLYWOOD furniture?

POLYWOOD lumber colors run continuously throughout the material, so no painting is required. We do not recommend painting your furniture as this will void the warranty.

Is it safe to use chairs with sling material in chlorine and saltwater pools?

Yes, but don't leave them in swimming pools permanently. Remove the chairs and rinse with fresh water when you're finished.

What is the warranty of POLYWOOD's sling material?

Our sling fabric has a three-year residential warranty. View our warranty page.

What companies supply POLYWOOD's fabric and sling material?

We source our fabric from Sunbrella® and Revolution Fabrics, and we source our sling material from Phifertex®.

What is the weight capacity of POLYWOOD chairs?

In accordance with ASTM standards, single seats are weight tested up to 350 lbs., two-seater chairs are weight tested up to 300 lbs. per seat, and three-seater chairs are weight tested up to 250 lbs. per seat.

What are the weight restrictions for sling material?

All of our chairs are weight tested up to 350 pounds.

Can the sling material withstand harsh weather?

Our all-weather sling fabric resists not only mildew, fading, and tearing, but also extreme environmental conditions, including blizzards, salt spray, humidity, hot sun, and more.

What type of hardware is used in POLYWOOD furniture?

For optimal performance and longevity, we use high-performance marine-grade quality hardware for the assembly and construction of all POLYWOOD furniture.

Do you recommend covering POLYWOOD furniture?

Since POLYWOOD furniture is all-weather, it does not require a cover. However, covering your furniture will make seasonal cleaning easier while also prolonging the life of your furniture.
